## **PLEASE BRING THESE BASIC PAPER PIECING SUPPLIES:**

- Sewing machine in good repair, that you know how to use. The manual may also be helpful.
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat and small (3" x 18" or 1" x 12") acrylic quilting ruler. The size is not terribly important, just so it has ¼" marks, which you will be using to trim the seam allowances.
- Common sewing supplies such as scissors or thread snips, straight pins, etc.
- Foundation paper – we have the Carol Doak foundation paper available at The Quilting Season.
- Fabric – either Fat Quarters (18" x 22" pieces of 100% cotton quilter's fabrics) or lots of large scraps – enough to make your project
- Use an **OLD** size 90/14 needle (since the paper will dull it quickly).
- Piecing Thread – Choose a color that will blend into most of your fabrics. Most all-purpose thread is 40-weight. If it does not say so right on the spool, it's safe to assume that it's 40-weight.
