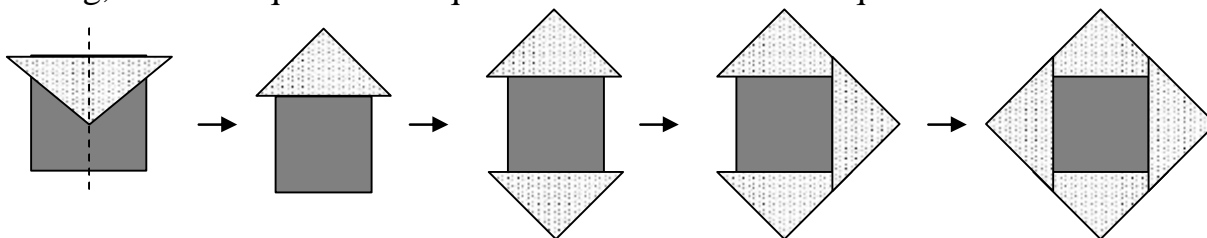


## The Cross Roads Block

☐ Light fabric – cut eight 3 inch squares

■ Dark fabric – cut four 2-5/8 inch squares

1. Cut each of the eight 3 inch light squares **ONCE** on the diagonal to make 16 triangles.
2. For each of the four square-within-a-square blocks, center the long side of a light triangle with the center of one of the dark squares (see below). Using a scant 1/4 inch seam, sew the triangle to the square. Press toward the triangle. Sew on remaining three triangles, starting with the opposite side. After pressing, trim the square-in-a-square unit to 3-1/2 inches square.



3. Make three additional square-in-a-square blocks in the same way, then sew them together. The final block should measure 6-1/2 inches square.
