

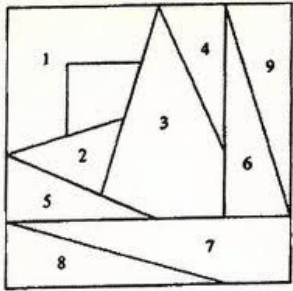

	<p>Crazy Quilting by Hand (Placemats) Thu Sep 29, 10am~3pm <u>and</u> Thu Oct 6, 10am~2pm \$40 for nine hours of instruction Instructor: Carolyn Knaggs</p>	<p>This 2 part class is taught by Carolyn Knaggs, who has been doing handwork for 25 years. Her baby quilts sell in the \$400 - \$500 range; one of her wall hangings is on permanent display in Brehm Tower at the Kellogg Eye Center, University of Michigan Medical Center. Carolyn says that by knowing just a few basic, simple stitches, you can embroider beautiful stitcheries. Although this is a handwork class, you'll need to bring your sewing machine to the 2nd class.</p>
	<p>Snowflakes Crocheted by Hand Sun Oct 2, 2~4:30pm Sun Oct 9, 2~4:30pm Sun Oct 16, 2~4:30pm Sun Oct 23, 2~4:30pm \$20 Instructor: Ursula Harder</p>	<p>Have you always wanted to learn how to crochet? This class starts at the total beginner level, so don't be shy. Come learn crochet with Ursula!</p> <p>Learn how to crochet with big yarn and a big needle. Then, when you're ready, start to crochet on a smaller scale to make these beautiful snowflakes that you can starch and hang as ornaments. Ursula shows you everything you need to know to create your own personal flurry of snowflakes.</p> <p>It will take four sessions to learn the basics of crochet, then start a snowflake or two.</p>
	<p>Introduction to Tatting Sat Oct 8, 1~3pm and Sat Oct 15, 1~3pm \$25 Instructor: Margaret Bradley</p>	<p>Tatting is very similar to macramé, but on a much smaller scale. You'll learn how to use a shuttle to make intricate, neat knots. Make a delicate trim for a dainty blouse, a bookmark, even earrings. Tatting can be used for all of those applications.</p>
<p>Quilt 'Til You Wilt! You Wilt!</p>	<p>Quilt 'Til You Wilt! Sat Oct 22, 10am~4pm \$10 Organizer: Mary Hogan</p>	<p>Bring your sewing machine project to work on. Everyone shares enthusiasm & encouragement! Optional to bring: a cushion for the hard chairs, & your favorite lunch or snack. Another lunch option: one of the three food purveyors in our mall.</p>
	<p>Folded Fabric Hexagons Mon Oct 24, 6~8pm \$15 Instructor: Mary Hogan</p>	<p>This is a brand new way to approach a hexagon quilt, often known as Grandmother's Flower Garden. Fold circles into hexagons, enclosing the batting. Then hand sew the hexagons together. The amazing part: the quilting is already done! This is primarily a <u>hand sewing technique</u>. In class you will be shown how it can be adapted to using a sewing machine.</p>
